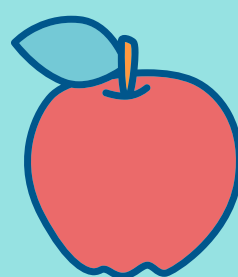
1 KHAN ACADEMY

Audible has opened up a free platform just for children. No subscription needed just click on the link and start listening to your favourite books, from Winnie the Pooh to Peter Rabbit.

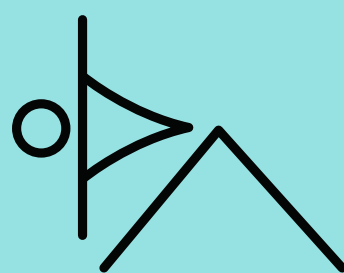


DAILY ACTIVITIES
